The goal of The Homeless and Unstably Housed Project was to improve the health outcomes of homeless and unstably housed persons by developing services and products for better care management and coordination. Healthix collaborated with Participants to identify intervention opportunities to connect with difficult-to-locate patients when they present at hospital emergency departments, jails, social service agencies, behavioral health organizations or other Participant facilities. The end goal was to coordinate care teams across diverse care settings who may be working independently, in a fragmented and uncoordinated manner to treat the same patient, with the aim of improving care and coordination of services for the homeless and unstably housed.
