 Updates Status of the PHIP grant Interactive Data Tutorial Healthcare Reopening Campaign 	Janine Logan reports on the status of the PHIP grant. Currently, the Population Health Improvement is included in the state budget for a one-year extension, but the LIHC has created a sustainability plan in case the budget does not pass. Funds from the State Department of Health are currently tied-up due to the COVID-19 pandemic. On July 16, from 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m., DataGen Principal Healthcare Informatics Analyst, Melissa Bauer, will host an interactive data tutorial on Adobe Connect. The tutorial will focus on managing the most recent SPARCS data, how to maneuver pivot tables, and how to pull relevant data. All LIHC members are invited to attend.
