

Individuals with serious mental illness (SMI)


Individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD)

Enhanced Services

Enhanced Nutrition Services

- Nutrition counseling and classes
- Cooking supplies
- Medically tailored meals
- Clinically appropriate meals
- Fruit and vegetable prescription
- Pantry stocking

Enhanced health-related housing supports

- Rent/Utility
- Navigation
- Community transitional services
- Pre-tenancy and tenancy sustaining services
- Home remediation and education
- Home accessibility and safety modifications
- Medical respite

Enhanced Care Management

- Outreach, referral management, and education including linkages to other state and federal benefit programs, application assistance and benefit program application
- Connection to clinical case management (i.e., health home and current case management)
- Connection to employment, education, childcare, and interpersonal violence resources
- Follow-up after services and linkages

Transportation to and from these supports



Medicaid Members

- 600,000 Waiver Eligible Members
 - Reached more than 50,000 members
 - Waiver-Eligible Unscreened Members: 550,000
- 260,000 Members eligible for Enhanced Services
 - Reached about 35,000 members
- \$68.2 million in PMPM to reimburse for services
 - Reimbursed \$1.7 million to date




