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# Featured Presentation

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## 2025 CHAS Responses Summary

- 467 surveys were collected between January 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025.
- There were 168 respondents for Nassau, 258 for Suffolk.
- 41 respondents did not belong to either Nassau or Suffolk County and were not included in the analysis.
- Results and highlights were reviewed at the March meeting
